

RULES FOR KEEPING ELIGIBILITY 8-BALL AND 9-BALL
THRU SUBSEQUENT SESSIONS AFTER
QUALIFYING AT TRI-CUP

1. MUST REMAIN CURRENT APA MEMBERS

2. TEAM MUST MAINTAIN ACTIVE TEAM STATUS

Every qualified team must play to retain eligibility. If your team qualified summer, then you must sign up again and play both the Fall and Spring Sessions in the League Area in which you qualified. A team that qualifies in the fall must continue on and play in the spring session in the League area in which you qualified.

3. TEAMS MUST RETAIN FOUR (4) "ORIGINAL" MEMBERS

In order for a team to retain eligibility for Higher Level Tournaments, at least four (4) members must be original members. A team that gains eligibility in the Summer Session must retain the same four (4) original members in the Fall and Spring Sessions.

4. 50% RULE FOR QUALIFIED TEAMS

Summer session teams that qualified must finish in the top half of their division in the subsequent Fall and Spring sessions of the current League year. Fall Session teams that qualify must finish in the top half of their division in the subsequent Spring session of the current League year. Team that do not finish in the top half of their division in the session(s) following qualification are subject to heavy scrutiny of their handicaps and/or loss of eligibility.

5. YOUR SPRING ROSTER IS YOUR HIGHER LEVEL TOURNAMENT ROSTER

Your actual spring roster will be the roster you must play with when you enter the Local Team Championship. Example: you qualified summer session & you have kept four (4) original players thru fall and spring session. You want to add a player back on to your team roster for spring session that was on the team when you qualified, that player must be added within the first 4 weeks of play of spring session. Once the fourth week of the Spring session has passed, the rosters of all eligible teams are frozen. No one may be dropped or added.

ALL CAPTAINS AND PLAYERS OF QUALIFIED TEAMS ARE REQUIRED TO READ THE COMPLETE RULINGS OF HIGHER LEVEL TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION AND RULES WHICH ARE ON PAGES 85 THRU 96 OF THE OFFICIAL TEAM MANUAL. SINCE CAPTAINS ARE THE ONES TO RECEIVE OFFICIAL TEAM MANUALS THEY SHOULD SIT DOWN WITH THEIR PLAYERS AND GO THRU THE PAGES OF HIGHER LEVEL TOURNAMENTS.
